SIX DAYS/FIVE NIGHTS

Day 1: We travel to Sault Ste. Marie - with a stop in Sudbury for a view of the “Big Nickel” and a tour of Science North. We then continue onto to Sault Ste. Marie – checking in the first-class **Quattro Hotel & Conference Centre** – for three nights. Dinner is on your own with many restaurants just steps from the hotel. (L)

Day 5: Our day is spent enjoying the scenic Manitoulin Island with a local guide. IN the late afternoon we head towards the dock to board the Chi-Cheemaun Ferry to Tobermory. For our final night, we check into Owen Sound’s # 1 hotel – the Best Western Inn on the Bay! (B)

Day 6: After enjoying our final breakfast, Owen Sound is to be discovered – with optional tours to either the Tom Thomson Gallery or the Billy Bishop Museum. We board the coach for a scenic ride through the Collingwood area, arriving home in the early evening. (B)
