Day 1 - Welcome to Windsor

This morning we depart for Windsor. Upon our arrival, we will visit the "John Freeman Walls Historical Site and Underground Railway Museum". At this location, you will meet direct descendants of the underground railway and "conductors" (tour guides) will take "passengers" (you) on an interactive trip back in time. The 1846 log cabin on site was built by John Freeman Wall and his wife, Jane King Walls, who rest in the family cemetery on the property. It is here that we will enjoy our (included) lunch. After lunch, we will stop at a local winery.

In the late afternoon you will check into your hotel – Windsor's waterfront CASEARS HOTEL. Upon checking in, you will receive \$ 30. in food coupons and \$ 20. in slot play coupons. The evening is then free to enjoy.

Day 2 – Rum Runners Adventure

This morning you will be met by "The Rum Runners Tour" acting troupe. The group will take you on a journey through prohibition of the 1920s and 1930s in Windsor. This tour includes a stop at a "speakeasy" restaurant for lunch (included) where you will enjoy entertainment from the Rum Runners troupe and the owner of the "speakeasy", Bertha.

We will return in the late afternoon with plenty of time to freshen up for your exciting three-hour Dinner/river cruise aboard the "Macassa Bay." Your cruise route will follow the south shore on the Windsor Essex side and then return following the north shore along the Detroit side. The scenery is spectacular as is the narrative about the history of these two cities.

Day 3 – Point Pelee Park

Point Pelee National Park is located in Essex County in Southwestern Ontario. The word pelee is French for "bald". Point Pelee consists of a peninsula of land, mainly of marsh and woodland habitats, that tapers to a sharp point as it extends into Lake Erie. A lush Carolinian forest oasis at the southern tip of Canada, Point Pelee National Park resounds with migrating song birds in the spring. We will take a trolley around the park to visit the most southern part in Canada.

In the late afternoon we will make our way back to the GTA.
