Seven day/Six nights

From a small oasis in the wilderness to expansive gardens of international renown, demonstration gardens to heritage properties, and native plant gardens to formal English-style gardens — Victoria is truly a gardener's paradise!



Victoria – otherwise known as the "City of Gardens" – is home to a number of spectacular gardens that range from formal to heritage, exotic to west coast and are all exciting to visit.

ITINERARY

Day One - Our group flight departs in the a.m. from Toronto – flying direct/non-stop and arriving in Victoria in the morning. After checking into our hotel (Huntingdon Hotel & Suites, Downtown Victoria) we start our discovery of Victoria with a walking tour of downtown. The remainder of the day is free. Our first day ends with an included dinner, a Scottish High Tea at the Pendray Inn & Tea House. (D)

Day Two –Today we tour the city of Victoria with our Driver/Guide. Our first stop will be a guided tour of the gardens at Government House, followed by a visit to some private gardens. Our day ends with a visit to Finnerty Gardens. Late afternoon and evening are free to possibly take a water taxi around the harbour. Dinner is on your own. (B)

Day Three –We head north of Victoria to experience the beautiful Butchart Gardens. Here we will be free to wander the gardens and then finish our visit with a "High Tea". En route back to Victoria, we will stop at the Gardens of the Horticulture Centre of the Pacific, for a guided tour. The remainder of the day is free. Dinner is on your own. (B,HT)

Day Four – Our day starts with a visit to some private gardens and then we head to Hatley Castle for lunch and a tour of the gardens. Today, we could also head to Beacon Hill Park and see the "running" of the goats – it will bring out the inner child in us. Dinner on your own. (B, L)

Day Five – Today we visit the Abkhazi Gardens for a stroll amongst their world-class garden. We then enjoy "High Tea" in their quaint Tea House. Dinner on your own. (B, HT)

Day Six – We head out to Sooke Harbour and a tour of their lovely gardens. The afternoon will be spent exploring Victoria and we end our day with a Farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day Seven – After breakfast, we board our coach for the transfer to the airport – bidding Victoria and all its lovely gardens, adieu. We arrive in Toronto early evening. (B)

• THE BUTCHART GARDENS

Spectacular beauty in all seasons at this National Historic Site and is still owned by the Butchart family. With over one million visitors each year, this garden ranks as the top garden in Canada.

Named one of the ten best gardens in Canada by the Ottawa Citizen, this 43-hectare site includes a nature conservancy and demonstration gardens.

Highlights include magnificent rhododendrons, and a collection of bonsai in the serene Takata Japanese Garden.

• FINNERTY GARDENS

One of Canada's best collections of rhododendrons is on display in the Finnerty Gardens. This 6.5-acre garden contains over 4,000 different trees and shrubs with more than 1,500 rhododendron and azalea plants, including 200-plus collected rhododendron species and a spectacular range of companion plants. Three ponds provide habitat for birds and plants such as the towering timber bamboo.
