We will then make our way to Halifax, where you'll have the opportunity to discover the city's rich maritime heritage, picturesque downtown and waterfront districts, and undeniably warm hospitality.



From Halifax we will also explore Lunenburg, and Peggy's Cove, showcasing the very best of Nova Scotia's seaside charm. We will also discover the beauty of the Annapolis Valley/Bay of Fundy.

We will then settle in for a scenic, stress-free return to Montreal aboard VIA Rail's The Ocean train (overnight train in a sleeper car)—then our own motorcoach, for a quick drive to Toronto.

This week-long adventure includes all transportation (flight to Sydney and return train/bus to Toronto), accommodation, tours with local guides by deluxe private motor

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 – Friday June 5th, 2026

Toronto to Sydney

This morning you will fly from Toronto to Sydney, Nova Scotia. When we arrive in Sydney in the early afternoon, you will be transferred to your hotel in beautiful Baddeck, your home for the next two nights. Check in to your hotel and rest of the evening at leisure. (D)

Overnight in Baddeck

Day 2 – Saturday June 6th, 2026

Cabot Trail

Today we will be joined by a local guide for a leisurely drive along the Cabot Trail, often hailed as one of the world's most scenic drives. The road winds through the Cape Breton Highlands, offering spectacular views of the Gulf of St. Lawrence, dense forests, and dramatic cliffs. Along the way, stop at quaint fishing villages, where you can experience the warmth of local hospitality and enjoy freshly caught seafood. This is a full day tour with stops enroute. (B,L)



Overnight in Baddeck

Day 3 – Sunday June 7th, 2026

Cape Breton to Halifax

This morning, after a leisurely breakfast, we will make our journey from Cape Breton to Halifax. We will start with a visit to the Alexander Graham Bell Historic Site. We will continue our drive, stopping for a visit and lunch in Antigonish – “the Highland Heart of Nova Scotia”. and make a few stops of interest enroute. We check into our hotel late afternoon. Evening is free to explore the Harbor front shops and restaurants. (B)

Overnight in Halifax

Day 4 – Monday June 8th, 2026

Halifax, Lunenburg, and Peggy's Cove

Your day will begin after breakfast with a professionally guided tour of Halifax, noting attractions from iconic lighthouses to urban gardens, stunning galleries and museums and a waterfront science center. Continuing the tour, you'll move on to Mahone Bay, Lunenburg, and Peggy's Cove. Located on Nova Scotia's spectacular South Shore, Mahone Bay was recently named one of Canada's top ten most beautiful towns. Lunenburg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site – with its narrow streets and unique architecture – is the home port of the Bluenose II. This graceful ship is a replica of the original fishing boat, enjoy a photo stop. Your final stop before heading back to Halifax will be Peggy's Cove, famous for its lighthouse, and one of the most iconic images in Eastern Canada. (B)

Overnight in Halifax

Day 5 – Tuesday June 9th, 2026

Annapolis Valley

Today we will travel west and drive to Digby, also known as the “Scallop Capital of the World”. This quaint village is also known for its stunning scenery, including dramatic views of the Annapolis Basin and the Bay of Fundy. Free time for lunch on your own in Digby. We then make our way to the Annapolis Royal Historic Gardens, a beautiful setting overlooking a tidal river valley. The Historic Gardens is a premiere Nova Scotia attraction showcasing gardening methods, designs and material representing more than four hundred years of local history. Before we commence back to Halifax, we will stop by to try some of wines at a local vineyard. Dinner is on your own, in Halifax. (B)

Overnight in Halifax

Day 6 – Wednesday June 10th, 2026

Depart Halifax on VIA's The Ocean

After a leisurely breakfast we will do a quick final tour of Halifax and then depart for the Via Station in Halifax. Here we will embark on an overnight journey on board ‘The Ocean’ Via Train to Montreal. Your rail experience will be in a private room with 2 armchairs and 2 retractable stacked beds. Your room also includes a vanity and an ensuite toilet. We will enjoy lunch and a three-course dinner today in the dining car. (B,L,D)

Overnight on VIA's “The Ocean” Train

Day 7 – Thursday June 11th, 2026

Return to Toronto

Wake up this morning and enjoy your breakfast in the dining car. We should arrive in Montreal around 10:00am. We will need to disembark the train (you will need to pick up your checked luggage). Then we will board our private motorcoach to make our way to the GTA. A lunch stop will be made along our way home. (B)
