From Halifax we will also explore Lunenburg, and Peggy's Cove, showcasing the very best of Nova Scotia's seaside charm. We will also discover the beauty of the Annapolis Valley/Bay of Fundy.

We will then make our way to Baddeck - which will be our home base for experiencing the Cabot Trail and Cape Breton's dramatic coastline. We will explore this legendary trail, often hailed as one of the world's most scenic drives, as well as quaint Celtic fishing villages throughout the Cape Breton Highlands.

We will then settle in for a scenic, stress-free return from Halifax to Montreal aboard VIA Rail's The Ocean train (overnight train in a sleeper car)– then board our own motorcoach, for a quick drive to the GTA.

This week-long adventure includes all transportation (flight to Halifax and return train/bus to Toronto), accommodation, tours with local guides by deluxe private motor coach, and the services of Shirlye, your HNA Travels Tour Director.

## Tour Itinerary

### Day 1 – Friday June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2026

#### Toronto to Halifax - Overnight in Halifax

This morning you will fly from Toronto to Halifax, Nova Scotia (direct/non-stop). When we arrive in Halifax in the early afternoon, you will begin your exploration with a walking tour of Halifax and the option of visiting the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic. We then check into our downtown hotel, your home for the next two nights. The rest of the evening is at your leisure to find that perfect restaurant for dinner.

### Day 2– Saturday June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2026

#### Halifax, Lunenburg, and Peggy's Cove - Overnight in Halifax

Your day will begin after breakfast with a professionally guided tour of Halifax, noting attractions from iconic lighthouses to urban gardens, stunning galleries and museums and a waterfront science center. Continuing the tour, you'll move on to Mahone Bay, Lunenburg, and Peggy's Cove. Located on Nova Scotia's spectacular South Shore, Mahone Bay was recently named one of Canada's top ten most beautiful towns. Lunenburg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site – with its narrow streets and unique architecture – is the home port of the Bluenose II. This graceful ship is a replica of the original fishing boat, enjoy a photo stop. Your final stop before heading back to Halifax will be Peggy's Cove, famous for its lighthouse, and one of the most iconic images in Eastern Canada. (B)

### Day 3 – Sunday June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026


#### Halifax to Cape Breton - Overnight in Baddeck

We start our day off with a visit to Wolfville/Annapolis Valley/Bay of Fundy. Here you will have a short, guided tour of the area and then time to stroll, enjoying lunchtime at your leisure (\$). Then our travels take us to Baddeck – home of the Cabot Trail. Our next two nights will be at the fabulous Inverary Resort in Baddeck. After checking in, we will stroll to their waterfront restaurant for a lovely, included dinner. (B, D)

### Day 4 – Monday June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026

#### Explore the Cabot Trail - Overnight in Baddeck

Today we will be joined by a local guide for a leisurely drive along the Cabot Trail, often hailed as one of the world's most scenic drives. The road winds through the Cape Breton Highlands, offering spectacular views of the Gulf of St. Lawrence, dense forests, and dramatic cliffs. Along the way, stop at quaint fishing villages, where you can experience the warmth of local hospitality. Our included lunch will be at a local Cabot Trail restaurant. We will also stop to visit "Les Trois Pignons for a special view into Acadian culture and the history of Chéticamp. Plus see a stunning collection of hooked rugs and antiques. (B,L)



## **Day 5 Tuesday June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026**

### **Cape Breton to Halifax - Overnight in Halifax**

This morning, after a leisurely breakfast, we will make our journey from Cape Breton to Halifax. We will start with a visit to the Alexander Graham Bell Historic Site. We will continue our drive, stopping for a visit and lunch in Antigonish – “the Highland Heart of Nova Scotia”. We check into our hotel late afternoon. Evening is free to explore the Harbor front shops and restaurants. (B)

## **Day 6 – Wednesday June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026**

### **Depart Halifax on VIA Rail’s “ The Ocean” - Overnight on VIA’s “The Ocean” Train**

After a leisurely breakfast we will do a quick final tour of Halifax and then depart for the Via Station in Halifax. Here we will embark on an overnight journey on board ‘The Ocean’ Via Rail Train to Montreal. Your rail experience will be in a private room with 2 armchairs and 2 retractable stacked beds. Your room also includes a vanity and an ensuite toilet. We will enjoy lunch and a three-course dinner today in the dining car. (B,L,D)

## **Day 7 – Thursday June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026**

### **Return to Toronto**

Wake up this morning and enjoy your breakfast in the Via Rail dining car. We should arrive in Montreal around 10:00 am. We will then disembark the train (you will need to pick up your checked luggage) and will board our private motorcoach to make our way to the GTA. A lunch stop will be made along our way home. (B)

- Two nights at the Inverary Resort in Baddeck Bay, Cape Breton

- Private highway motor coach transportation during your stay in Nova Scotia
- Over-night on “The Ocean” Sleeper Plus of Via Rail – Halifax to Montreal – *note that this experience is valued at over \$ 1,000.*
- Private motor coach from Montreal train station to the GTA.
- Experience the Cabot Trail – a day long experience
- Your package will include lots of sightseeing
